What is it: On Saturday, July 31, 2010, the Scouting family — past, present and future — will be able take part in a special nationwide broadcast from the 100th Anniversary National Jamboree at Fort AP Hill, Virginia.

The Occoneechee Council will be one of only six councils in the entire nation to broadcast a signal back to the Jamboree! The scouts at the National Jamboree will see us watching them as we join them in the closing ceremony of the National Jamboree! **We will truly be a part of the National Jamboree!**

Who can participate: Anyone and everyone is invited to attend the simulcast. This will be a historical moment in the 100th Anniversary of Scouting and we want everyone to be a part of this event!

What is the cost: \$5 per person attending. Food and Drink vendors will be available at the stadium. Children under 3 years of age are free to attend, but will not get an individual seat unless you pay for one.

Do we register as individuals or as a unit: Packs, Troops, & Crews are encouraged to bring their scouts and families as an entire unit; however anyone can attend as an individual family. All youth must be accompanied by an adult or be properly supervised. Tickets will be mailed to the person listed below or may be picked up at the Council Service Center. (Pack 352 is trying to sit together, so please fill out the form below)

Will there be any other activities: Prior to the simulcast we will be demonstrating that our “**Scouts Have Talent**”. If you have a special talent that you would like to share (singing, playing an instrument, playing in a band, magic tricks, etc) please send us a video (2 minute maximum) by June 30th for consideration at the address shown below. **If selected, you will be performing live at the Shinning Light event and could be seen nation wide!**

Will there be a patch: Of course there will be a patch! In fact, the patch for this event will be one of the segments in the “arrowhead puzzle patch” of activities that highlight the events surrounding the 100th Anniversary of Scouting in the Occoneechee Council. Patches will be handed out at the Durham Bulls gate on the day of the event.

Is there a deadline: Yes there is limited seating for this event at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (3,500) and we have 14,000 youth members, plus parents, brothers & sisters, grandparents, and alumni of scouting. **This will be a sell out- Get your ticket order in early! (Pack 352, the RSVP deadline is June 30th, 2010)**
