



# JOIN US FOR A COACH BUS DAY TRIP TO THE 2010 B.S.A. NATIONAL JAMBOREE!



The Occoneechee Council will lead a bus trip to Fort A.P. Hill, Virginia to visit the Jamboree on Friday, July 30, 2010. This once-in-a-lifetime experience will depart Raleigh (with possible additional pick ups in Durham and Fayetteville) at approximately 5:00 a.m. and return the same day at approximately 11 p.m. Visitors will have between approximately 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. to observe\* and visit the 65,000 Scouts and Scouters who comprise the 100th Anniversary's largest and best display of Boy Scouting in the United States!

**Who can attend?** Registered Occoneechee Council youth, adults, and their family members; family and friends of the Occoneechee Jamboree contingent members; and Scouting alumni. Youth, ages 5 to 17, must be accompanied by an adult. Children under five years old are not permitted on this bus trip.

**What is the cost?** \$50 per person. Includes round-trip coach bus transportation fees, an ID lanyard, a custom designed Day Trip souvenir item, and dinner on the way home. Additional money for lunch at Jamboree, souvenirs, etc. will be the responsibility of each participant.

**What is the process to sign up?** Fill out the form below and mail it in. Registration paperwork and full payment must be completed in full by April 23, 2010.

**Important considerations:** This event will involve considerable amounts of walking across varied terrain (paved, gravel and dirt roads; trails; stairs; grassy fields; hills). The weather will likely be very warm. Participants should be prepared to walk a minimum of 8-10 miles over the course of the day. All participants will be expected to complete and carry health information and a medical release form on their person (registered BSA members can use their Annual Health and Medical Record). Once registered, you will receive detailed information how to prepare, medical and safety procedures, and travel details.

\* Please note: Visitors are not permitted to participate in Action Centers &/or Program Activities. These are exclusively for Jamboree participants.
