Raven Rock State Park

Raven Rock State Park is a bit of a drive, but by all accounts it is worth it! This state park has trails that overlook the Cape Fear River, and has some really interesting geological formations and unusual growths of rhododendron and mountain laurel.

We will plan on taking the Raven Rock Loop and Little Creek Loop Trails for a combined duration around four miles long.

Directions From Raleigh:

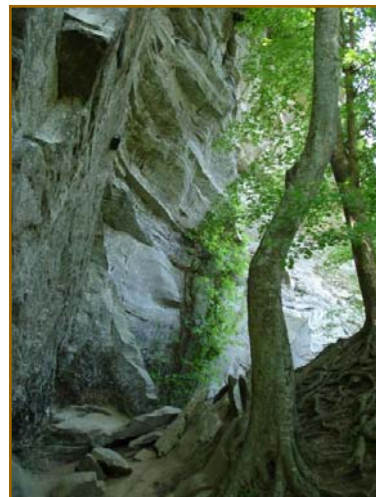
Google maps gives an estimated travel time of 1.5 hrs from St. Francis of Assisi.

- Take 540 W to 40 E, and then US 1 towards Sanford.
- Take exit 70A off US 1 to merge onto the US-421 Bypass S.
- Turn left at Broadway Rd/US-421 Bypass S.
- Take a slight right at Cox Mill Rd/US-421 Bypass S.
- Turn left at US-421 S.
- Turn left into the park at Raven Rock Rd

What to bring: Water, small snack, good shoes, and a positive attitude!
