November 18-19 CSS Neuse. Civil War Navy Living History program. Cannons will thunder and sailors and Marines will converge on the banks of the Neuse River once again as the site hosts its annual Civil War living history program. Members of several North Carolina and Virginia reenactment/living history organizations will be demonstrating all aspects of period naval life including nautical skills, navigational techniques, and daily shipboard living. This year's program will feature more sailors and marines, as well as new civilian interpretations. Old South Blacksmiths will once again demonstrate how the blacksmith shops in Kinston made various items for the ship and artillery units. They will also have some items for sale to the general public. Other sutlers/craftsmen at the program will include Heritage Leathers.

This year's program will once more offer visitors a rare opportunity, a special artillery firing after dark Saturday. Gates will reopen at 6:30 p.m. and the demonstration will take place at 7 p.m. Visitors should bring a flashlight to help them find their way to the demonstration area. This is a spectacular demonstration on the banks of the Neuse!

The site orientation video and ship tours will be available both days plus the ship's shop will be open. 10 a.m.- 4 p.m., Saturday; 7-8 p.m. Saturday evening; and 12 noon -4 p.m., Sunday.

Come for the day, or stay overnight. The Pack has 15 rooms reserved at the Holiday Inn Express in Kinston, or you can camp for free at the Neuseway State Park. The park administration is opening the park up for the weekend to any scouts who wish to camp there.
