

## **Pack 352's Pinewood Derby race to be held on January 12<sup>th</sup>!**

The pinewood derby is one of the most popular and successful family activities in Cub Scouting. Pinewood derby cars are small wooden models that boys make with help from their families and then race in competition. The cars are powered by gravity and run down a regulation track. The pinewood derby is an annual event. Every scout can design and build his own "grand prix" car to enter in the race. Car kits and rules for design and racing are provided. Please note a change to the rules. This year each scout will be assigned a number with the car kit they receive. That number is assigned to their car for the race event and should be incorporated into the design of the car. We will not use stickers to number the cars at the race event.
