

Baltimore Inner Harbor Trip November 1 – 2, 2008



Day 1: USS Constellation, Saturday, November 1, 2008

The USS Constellation Museum's Overnight Adventure offers groups a unique opportunity to walk in the footsteps of sailors and learn about the life aboard a mid-19th century, U.S. Navy warship. Participants in the overnight program become USS Constellation's newest crew members. Younger participants sign on as Ship's Boys (powder monkeys). The adults sign on as Landsmen. Both ranks denote novice sailors.

Cost: \$50 per participant

- Includes two meals (Saturday evening supper & Sunday morning breakfast), bed (hammock), all activities, and trained educators
- Program begins sharply at 5:00 pm on Saturday, November 1, 2008 and concludes at 9:00 am on Sunday, November 2, 2008.
- Maximum number of participants: 60 **Spots will be filled on a first come basis!**
- Minimum age: 1st grade **Under 6 can NOT sleep on the ship**
- **One parent/guardian must stay on the ship with your scout/child(ren).**
- Constellation patches and Civil War naval caps available in the ship's store
- Required USS Constellation forms:
 - "Overnight Program - Parental Release Form" – one per child/scout and
 - "Overnight Program - Adult Waiver Form" – one per adult

This 19th century fort was the site of the Baltimore victory over the British in the War of 1812 and the raising of the Star Spangled Banner. This event inspired Francis Scott Key to write our National Anthem. The star-shaped fort and surrounding grounds have been restored for exploration by visitors.
